Splash Car Wash reopened two express wash locations in Brockport and Spencerport, New York.

Customers who donated to the Foodlink of Rochester Splash over the weekend of May 5th were able to receive free washes. Foodlink is a non-profit organization dedicated to addressing both the root causes and effects of food insecurity throughout the Greater Rochester area and Finger Lakes region.

Formerly Buckman Car Washes, the newly re-branded Splash sites underwent extensive internal and external renovations, including the addition of new equipment in each wash tunnel. Additionally, the company has added multiple self-service vacuums at each site that are free of charge to customers. The two locations had special offers for customers who stopped by May 5th through 7th.

Splash currently operates 57 locations in New York, Connecticut, and Vermont. The company is currently in the final stages of build out at four new locations in New York and Connecticut, which are expected to open in the next month. In addition, the brand has four more sites under construction in Massachusetts, Vermont, and Connecticut.
